Reclaimed Water

Reclaimed water is recycled wastewater that is used to water our lawns and lowers our utility bill. Reclaimed water helps to maintain the Florida Aquifer. This water is unsuitable for consumption, bathing, cooking or connection with another water source.

Stormwater

Stormwater is the number one source of water pollution in our area. Storm drains lead directly to our waterways with no filters from our yards. Rain can carry chemicals, oil and trash from our yards to the Bay and Gulf where it can harm fish and other aquatic life. Our Water



Water service is provided by Pinellas County Utilities and usage is determined by water meters located on the property. The Association is billed for both water consumption and waste water (sewage) based on the meter readings.

Help keep our Utilities cost down by:

Repair leaks in your unit. A continually running toilet can waste potentially 200 gallons a day. A dripping faucet can lose between 2-20 gallons of water a day.

Notify the property manager immediately of any exterior water leaks. This would include the pool area where issues may go unnoticed for extended periods.

Report any broken sprinkler heads which can waste up 20 gallons of water per minute.
